Working at a supermarket selling haram products

Question:

AssalamuAlaikum, Is working at Woolworths, Coles, or Aldi haram?

Answer:

بسم الله الرحمن الرحيم

وعليكم السلام ورحمة الله وبركاته

It is permissible to work in a supermarket and or on the check out of a supermarket that sells Haram products (such as pork, alcohol, wine, or food items with haram ingredients). Income from such a job would be permissible.

- One should, however, dislike such items in one's heart: loving that which Allah loves and hating that which Allah hates is a form of faith.
- This ruling is for muslims in a non-Muslim country or in non-Muslim areas in a Muslim country.
- It is not permitted to sell such items in one's own supermarket. If one does, it is sinful. The revenue generated from such sales is unlawful.
- It is not haram to touch unlawful items, especially when there is a need. Normally, meats are wrapped, and the alcohol in bottles.

Note: Jobs where you are not carrying out, encouraging, or protecting Haram. And you are not working for a company, business or a retailer where the main or most actions are haram but are handling haram items, are Halal and permissible.
